What is a Competent Authority?

A Competent Authority is an organisation that you are required to register with in order to practice your profession in a particular jurisdiction.

The Dental Council of Ireland is the competent authority for the dental profession in the Republic of Ireland.

The General Dental Council is the competent authority for the dental profession in the UK and Northern Ireland. In some jurisdictions you may be required to register with two organisations in order to legally practice your profession. Both should be listed in this instance. These are usually the organisations that you will retrieve Letters of Good Standing and/or compliance letters from.
